SERVICES OFFERED BY THE CITY OF WINNIPEG:



Garbage / Recycling:

The City of Winnipeg provides special services to residents living in their own homes that are physically unable to put out their own garbage & recycling. This service is called **Walk-up Collection Services**. There is no additional fee for this service.

Who is Eligible for this Service?

Available to residents who are functionally unable to get their recycling and garbage carts to the curb or lane and have no one in the house who can do this.

How do I receive the Walk-up Collection Service?

To apply, please call **311** to have an application form mailed to you or download the Walk-up Collection Service Application form from <https://winnipeg.ca/waterandwaste/pdfs/ApplicationforWalk-upService2017.pdf>. You will need a health care professional to sign your initial application. You need to reapply for this service each year.

Snow removal (for street access from boulevard only):

If you are physically unable to shovel a boulevard pathway to access your street, you can apply to the City of Winnipeg to clear it for you. Private boulevard crosswalks between the sidewalk and the curb will be cleared to a width of 0.7 meters after the street clearing operations are completed. Properties with front driveways do not qualify for this service.

The following criteria must be met to qualify for this special service:

- The property owner/occupant has an accessibility issue and is physically incapable of shoveling snow (copy of medical certificate is required for all new applicants). This service is not provided for those with a short-term disability/handicap (e.g. knee surgery).
- No other able-bodied person resides in the property owner's/occupants house.
- The property owner/occupant is unable to arrange to have this work done by others due to financial circumstances.

How do I receive the Snow Removal Service?

To apply, please call **311** to have an application form mailed to you. A doctor's certificate is required along with the application form, and a By-Law Enforcement Constable may personally interview you to verify that you are eligible.
