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Notes/Other Considerations:



This safe work procedure was created by The Provincial Workplace Safety and Health MSIP Subcommittee and will be reviewed any time the task, equipment or materials change and at a minimum of every three years from the last revision date.

	Steps to be taken to complete task safely
1	Select appropriate size slider according to patient size. If patient can assist or requires minimal assist to roll, HCWs are positioned on either side of patient. HCW#1 pushes/rolls patient towards HCW#2 by shifting weight up and forward. HCW#2 maintains patient in place while HCW#1 positions sliders. Repeat on opposite side.
2	Two HCWs stand on opposite sides of the bed. Position bed at the waist height of the shortest person. Ensure brakes are on and side rails are lowered.
3	Lay two sliders on top of patient. HCWs grasp both sliders at one end. Fold sliders into hand width sections, leaving two hand widths unfolded at opposite end.
4	Position slider with folds facing down and the open end at the starting point (head or feet as needed). If inserting from head, place under pillow. If inserting from feet, slide under heels or knees.
5	HCWs face the end of the bed where sliders have been placed. Use a wide base of support with one foot in front of the other. With palm facing up, grasp bulk of folds with hand closest to patient (do not use thumb). To begin, hold open end with hand farthest from patient. Keep elbows at sides.
6	HCWs communicate and shift weight from front to back leg at the same time to unfold sliders. Repeat until sliders are completely unfolded.
7	When attempting to unfold past bony prominences or heavier body parts such as the shoulder blade or buttocks, use outside hand to push down on the surface to create space for the sliders or use sawing motion to pass sliders past the area.
8	Remove sliders by reaching underneath the bottom slider and grasping the opposite corner. Turn slider underneath itself and pull out at a 45-degree angle. Repeat with other slider as necessary.
