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This safe work procedure was created by The Provincial Workplace Safety and Health MSIP Subcommittee and will be reviewed any time the task, equipment or materials change and at a minimum of every three years from the last revision date.

Notes/Other Considerations:

- If more than minimal assistance is required by each HCW, additional HCWs, alternative procedures and/or equipment may be required (e.g., mechanical floor or overhead lift).
- If behavior interferes with care, alternate procedures and/or equipment may be required

Steps to be taken to complete task safely

- HCW adjusts bed to avoid stooping and ensure patient's feet are close to floor following transfer. Apply bed brakes. HCW #1 is positioned at head of bed beside patient's head. HCW #2 is positioned near patient's feet.
- Position patient with bent elbow in line with edge of bed.



Bend patient knee furthest from direction of roll or cross the legs at ankle.

In a wide base of support with one foot in front of the other or knee on the bed, HCWs place hands on the client's hip and shoulder and provide minimal assistance to roll patient using weight shift.









HCW #1 stands at side of bed facing the patient with a wide base of support, one foot slightly in front of the other. Elbows are held close to side. HCW #1 places one hand on patient's shoulder and opposite hand on hip or thigh. As HCW #2 guides legs off bed, patient is asked to assist to push up using the bottom elbow and top hand as able. HCW #1 shifts weight and guides patient into sitting at the shoulder and pressing downward on hips.





Option 1: HCW #2 stands with wide base of support, facing the patient. HCW #2 grasps patient's legs with both hands at the ankle or shin. HCW #2 squats down while guiding patient's legs off the side of the bed. Add slider under legs if necessary.



HCW #1 places hand on patient's shoulder to help maintain balance, as necessary. Adjust height of bed as needed to lower to a safe transfer height. Both HCWs can assist patient to move forward on bed as required ensuring that the patient's feet are flat on the floor.

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Option 1: To assist to lie, HCW #2 places a slider on the edge of bed, tucking it under the thigh. HCW #2 positions him/herself in a low position facing foot of the bed. HCW #2 places hands onto the upper shin of the patient and pushes leg(s) across slider onto the bed while shifting weight forward. HCW #1 guides upper body towards bed. Remove slider.







Option 2: HCW #2 wraps slider or alternative around lower limb. HCW #2 holds ends while standing at foot of bed, keeping elbows close to body. HCW #2 walks backwards while pulling legs onto bed. HCW #1 guides upper body towards bed. Remove slider or alternative from limbs.
