Community Therapy Services (CTS) is seeking a Program Coordinator for the [First Nations Physiotherapy Program](#) (FNPP). The Program Coordinator is responsible for overseeing the general administration of the program while providing physiotherapy services to 7-8 communities on a rotational basis. Weekly overnight travel is expected.

Compensation is at the Senior Physiotherapist rate as per [MAHCP](#) Scale. Meal Allowances, accommodations and travel is compensated in accordance with the most recent collective agreement.

- Minimum three years' experience in supervisory, senior, or service lead position
